



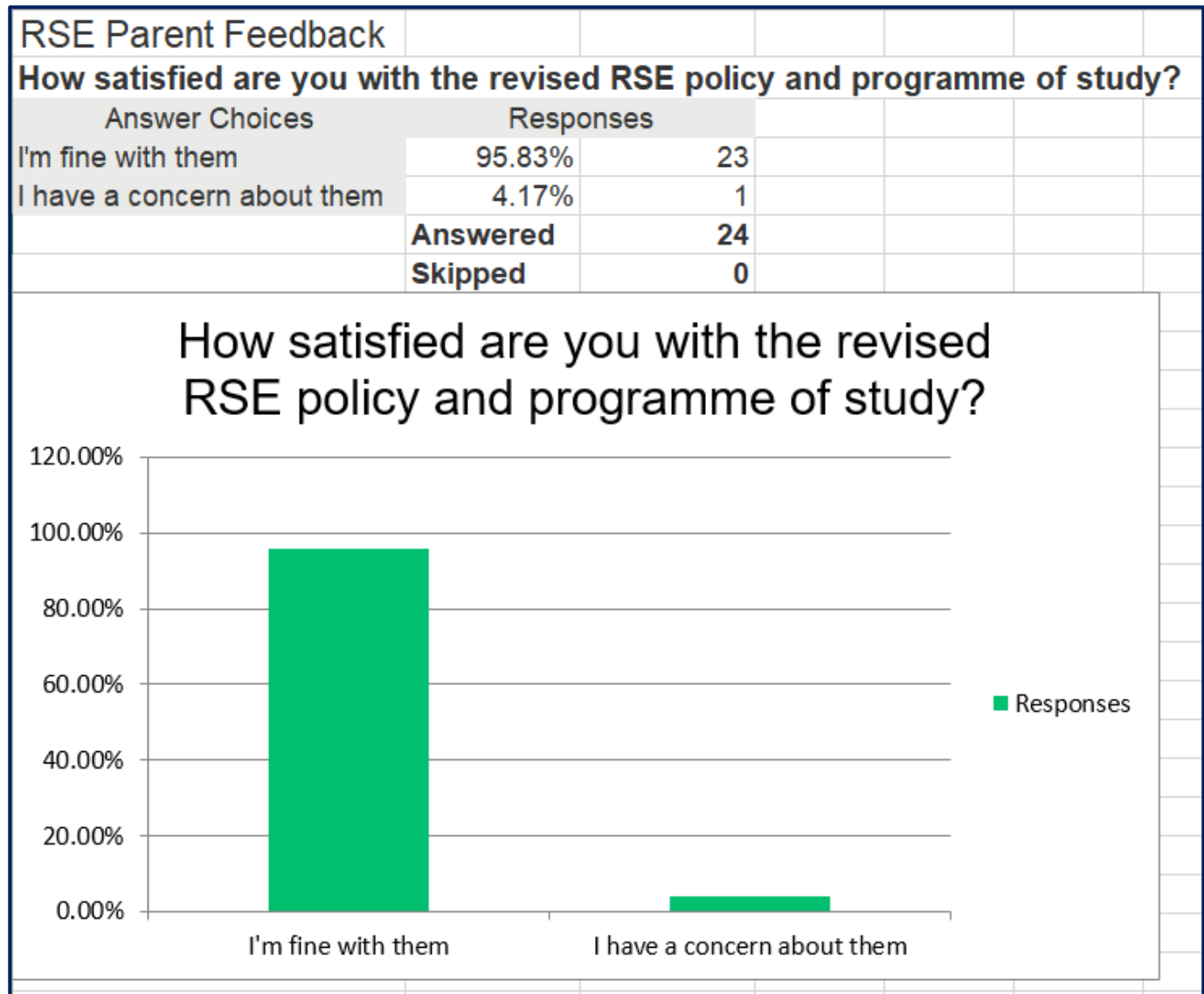
Aiming for Excellence
